#### Kindergarten Registration:

Kindergarten (ECS) registration is being taken online through the CES website for the 2023-2024 school year. Children who are 5 years of age or who will be 5 years of age before December 31, 2023, they are eligible for ECS.

Registration will not be accepted without a valid birth certificate.

#### Early Learning Program Registration:

To be eligible for ELP, children must be 3.9 years of age as of September 1, 2023. Children with identified speech and language delays and/or physical challenges may register when they are 3 to access the many benefits of early learning.

AM- 8:30-11:30 or PM 12:20-3:25PM Monday - Thursday

This is a fee-based program with each half day costing \$41.75 per month.

#### **LEAGUE PLAY:**
